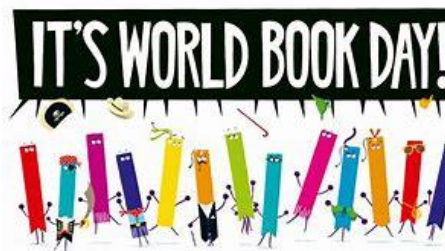
### School Council Craft
